Information, rules and conditions

EVENT: This event has been licenced at Level 4 – licence numbers 4WM252477 and will be held under A.S.A. Law & A.S.A. Technical Rules. It's an internal event only for members of Rugby Swimming Club Swimming Club.

VENUE: The Queens Diamond Jubilee Centre, Bruce Williams Way, Rugby, Warwickshire, CV22 5LJ.

POOL: The length of the pool is 25m (eight lanes) with Swiss Timing Quantum Aquatics electronic timing and OMEGA timing pads. The depth of water at the shallow end is 1 metre and at the deep end is 2.5 metres. There is also a secondary strobe light available for those who need it.

AGE GROUPS: 8 and under, 9/10 years, 11/12 years, 13/14 years, 15/over. Age is at 23/11/25

ENTRY TIMES: There are no minimum and maximum times you need to swim for this Meet. There is also no age limit – just check with your Coach that they're happy for you to enter. Some of the distances do have a minimum age requirement so be sure to check those in the terms and conditions.

AWARDS: The club will present awards to swimmers as detailed below:

25m/50m/100 Races:

Individual medals will be made to the <u>first six swimmers</u> in each age category: 8/under, 9/10, 11/12, 13/14 and 15/over. Winners will be announced at the event.

200m Races:

Individual medals will be made to the <u>first three swimmers</u> in the 9/10, 11/12, 13/14 and Senior (15/over) age groups

200m IM/400m Races:

Individual medals will be made to the <u>first three swimmers</u> in the 10, 11/12, 13/14 and Senior (15/over) age groups

POOLSIDE: Only Swimmers, Coaches, Personal Attendants with a pass and Officials will be allowed on poolside during the Meet.

Camping chair will not be allowed poolside. Competitors will be asked to remove them if necessary

SPECTATORS: There's a large balcony at the Centre and we are not charging spectators an entry fee. Wet swimmers are not allowed in the spectator area

PARKING: There is a large car park at the centre. Parking is free if your stay is less than 3 hours. Spectators parking longer than 3 hours will need to pay for parking. There is a charge of £1 for event parking

PHOTOGRAPHY: Sorry, you're not allowed to take any photos or videos inside The Queen's Diamond Jubilee Centre, unless permission is sought from the event organiser. You might be asked to leave if you do.

VOLUNTEERS AND OFFICIALS: Want to volunteer? Brilliant! We need everything from helpers and an announcer to training or qualified time keepers and judges to make this event a success – and you don't need previous

- 2. The competition will be held under A.S.A. Law & A.S.A. Technical Rules
- 3. There are NO QUALIFYING TIMES FOR THIS MEET
- 4. All events will be heat declared winners
- 5. Swimmers diving into the pool must have reached the standard of the A.S.A. Preliminary Competitive Start Award. Those who have not achieved this standard must start in the water. Coaches are to oversee their own swimmers during the warm up
- **6.** Swimmers can enter the following events, depending on their age:

- **7.** Age is at 23/11/25
- **8.** The Female category is for birth sex females in accordance with Swim England's Transgender and Non-Binary Competition Policy. By entering the 'Female' category, a swimmer confirms that their birth sex is female
- 9. Awards will be made to the first six swimmers in the 8/under, 9/10, 11/12, 13/14 and 15/over age groups, except in the 200m and 400m events where awards will be made to the first three swimmers in the 9/10, 11/12, 13/14 and 15/over age groups. In the 200m IM, awards will be made to the first three swimmers in the 10, 11/12, 13/14 and 15/over age groups.
- 10. Swimmers can enter a maximum of 6 events
- 11. Entry fee £5.00 per event or £25.00 for 6 events. Total fee must be paid at the time of entry.
- 12. Rugby swimmers are to enter the event using our online entry system at www.rugbyswimmingclub.co.uk.
- **13.** Email rugbyopen@rugbyswimmingclub.co.uk for the entry file set.
- **14.** Fees are non-refundable unless the entry is rejected or the event cancelled by the promoter.
- 15. The closing date for entries is midnight on Friday 14th November 2025. No entries will be accepted after the closing date
- 16. The Promoter reserves the right to restrict the number of entries, based on a 'First Come, First Served' basis
- **17.** By entering the competition, you agree to the swimmers name, age and entered events appearing on the Rugby Swimming Club and the ASA/Swim England websites in line with confirmed or rejected entries and published results.
- **18.** All details of accepted/rejected entries will be posted on the club website, www.rugbyswimmingclub.co.uk. All details must be checked by swimmers (or their guardians) and any changes notified immediately by email to rugbyopen@rugbyswimmingclub.co.uk. Refunds for any rejected entries will be made before the meet
- 19. Competitors not reporting in time for an event may be excluded from that event
- **20.** The start list will be printed before the event and if swimmers don't attend the heat will be swum with an empty lane. No changes can be made after the start list is created
- 21. Over the top and side by side (for backstroke) starts may be used
- 22. Start and estimated finish times are as stated in this information pack. If they need to change you'll find details on the club website
- 23. Sportsystems meet management system will be used to run the event
- **24.** We will be using a secondary strobe light for starts subject to availability at the pool
- 25. Any item not covered within these conditions will be at the sole discretion of the Promoter
- 26. Annual trophies must be signed for by the winner or the winner's parent/guardian if under 18 years of age
- 27. All events will be swum as heat declared winners (no finals)

Scoring events for overall best swimmer

In addition to awards presented on the day of the gala, there will be the Annual presentation evening held by Rugby Swimming Club whereby awards will be presented to the best overall swimmer, based on their performance at the club championships (highest points), and the most improved swimmer, as detailed below:

Best overall swimmer:

For ages 8 and 9 years, Points will be awarded for each race, with the best overall swimmer being awarded to the swimmer with the most total points, as follows:

1st place = 6 points 4th Place = 3 points
 2nd place = 5 points 5th Place = 2 points
 3rd Place = 4 points 6th Place = 1 point

For ages 10 years and over, Points will be awarded as follows:

 Highest total FINA points from their highest scoring 4 events. The best overall swimmer will be awarded to the swimmer with the most total points

The prizes are awarded to the top scoring boy and girl in the following ages-

- Best 15/over years girl and boy
- Best 14 years girl and boy
- Best 13 years girl and boy
- Best 12 years girl and boy
- Best 11 years girl and boy
- Best 10 years girl and boy
- Best 9 years girl and boy
- Best 8/under girl and boy

Most improved swimmer:

The most improved swimmer award will be decided by the coaching team and may not necessarily be awarded based on the results of this event.
